**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION  
OR STATUS REPORT**

On September 8, 2010, the Commission issued an order approving Missouri Gas Energy, a Division of Southern Union Company's Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge and rejecting the company's proposed tariff. On the same day, the company filed a revised tariff purportedly in compliance with the Commission's order. Although MGE filed the tariff with a 30-day effective date, the company requests that approval of the tariff be expedited and that the tariff take effect on September 18.

In an effort to accommodate the company, the Commission will require that the Staff of the Commission file either a recommendation as to whether the tariff is in compliance with the Commission's order, or that Staff file a status report informing the Commission of a date by which Staff will file a recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file no later than September 14, 2010, a pleading as set out in the body of this order.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
