On July 2, 2010, MoGas Pipeline, LLC filed an application to intervene. In response, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed suggestions in opposition to the application. An early prehearing conference is scheduled for July 29. So that parties may participate in early prehearing conference, disputes regarding intervention must be timely resolved.

Commission rule¹ allows 10 days for responsive pleadings. To facilitate a timely resolution of the issues presented with regard to MoGas' application to intervene and AmerenUE's opposition thereto, the Commission will shorten the time in which MoGas may respond to AmerenUE.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. MoGas Pipeline, LLC, may file a response to Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE no later than July 16, 2010.
