**ORDER APPROVING WNAR TARIFF**

Issue Date: March 16, 2022

Effective Date: April 1, 2022

On March 4, 2022, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West (collectively "Spire") filed proposed tariff sheets to reflect changes in its Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR) rates, bearing effective dates of April 1, 2022. Also on March 2, 2022, the Commission issued its Order Directing Expedited Staff Recommendation and Setting Time for Responses, requiring the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to submit its recommendation by March 11, 2022, and directing any other entity wishing to comment on the proposed tariff sheets to do so by the same date. Spire filed two separate substitute tariff sheets on March 9, 2022.

This is Spire's first WNAR filing since its most recent rate case, GR-2021-0108, in which the Commission allowed Spire to file a WNAR that changed the mechanism from a semiannual mechanism to an annual mechanism. The revised tariff sheets reflect WNAR amounts for April 1, 2022, through September 30, 2022. In addition to reflecting the approved WNAR amounts, the proposed tariff sheets remove the semiannual components that have expired.

On March 11, 2022, Staff filed its recommendation. Staff reviewed the tariff sheets submitted by Spire and recommended that the Commission approve them as substituted.

Staff stated that because the remaining semiannual period was cooler than normal, most notably with the month of February 2021, the proposed rates in this filing are negative. This means a residential customer in the Spire Missouri East district that used 100 Ccf in a given billing month would see a \$0.68 reduction in their monthly bill from the current WNAR rate, and a residential customer in the Spire Missouri West district would see a \$0.66 reduction in their monthly bill from the current WNAR rate.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets as substituted and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved. In addition, the Commission will make this order effective in less than thirty days so that the order will be effective concurrently with the tariff sheets. Therefore, the Commission will approve these tariff sheets, as substituted, to become effective on April 1, 2022.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The tariff sheets filed by Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West (Tariff No. JG-2022-0231, and No. JG-2022-0232), as substituted, are approved to become effective on April 1, 2022.
2. This order shall become effective on April 1, 2022.
3. This file shall close on April 2, 2022.
