2	(Proceedings commenced at 12:30 p.m.)
3	
4	JUDGE RUTH: Let's go ahead and
5	go on the record. If you can't hear me wave. If
6	you can hear me nod, all right. My name is Vicky
7	Ruth, and we are here for a local public hearing
8	in case number GR-2004-0072. Today is Monday,
9	February 9th, and the on the record portion of
10	this public hearing is beginning at 12:30.
11	There was a question and answer session
12	that began at twelve o'clock; however, it appears
13	that there are no witnesses here today.
14	CHAIR GAW: We may have one.
15	JUDGE RUTH: Let's take a
16	five-minute break.
17	(Off the record.)
18	(Back on the record.)
19	JUDGE RUTH: As I was saying, we
20	are here for a local public hearing in the Aquila
21	natural gas rate case. The purpose of today's
22	hearing is to allow the public an opportunity to
23	make comments regarding Aquila's proposed rate
24	increase which is approximately 5.6 million
25	dollars for Aquila Networks MPS and .8 million

dollars for Aquila Networks L&P.

As I stated before, my name is Vicky Ruth and I am the regulatory law judge assigned to this case. Also present today is the commission chair, Steve Gaw, to my right. We have a staff attorney present, Mr. Robert Franson. He works for the Missouri Public Service Commission. Dean Cooper is here representing Aquila. Mr. Cooper, thank you, too, and Mr. Douglas Micheel is here representing the Office of the Public Counsel. It is the public counsel's job to represent the public in matters before the Commission.

This is an official hearing of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and that means we have a reporter present. Anyone who wants to speak will need to be sworn in and a transcript will be made of the entire proceedings so that the other commissioners may read that.

In addition to today's local public hearing we have one this evening in Sedalia, and the Commission has also conducted local public hearings in Maryville, Platte City, Nevada and Rolla.

The trial type of evidentiary hearing will be held in late March and early April 2004 at the

1	Commission's office in Jefferson City, Missouri.
2	The hearing is open to the public, and the company
3	will have the burden of showing that the proposed
4	rate increase is necessary.
5	The procedure for today is as follows. If
6	anyone signs the witness sheet, I will call their
7	name. They will come forward to the microphone.
8	I will ask you your name and address and then give
9	you an opportunity to make your statement. After
10	you make your statement there could be a few
11	questions from either the chairman or one of the
12	other parties.
13	At this time is there anyone in the
14	audience who wants to make a comment or statement?
15	(No response)
16	JUDGE RUTH: Okay. At this time
17	then we do not have any witnesses signed up.
18	Chairman Gaw, would you like to make a few
19	remarks?
20	CHAIR GAW: I thank everybody
21	for coming. We would like to hear from people

for coming. We would like to hear from people though if they want to say something. That's the purpose of these things. It's not formal. It's just a question of whether anyone wants to add something. I'm not going to get anything, am I?
