NOTICE THAT WNAR TARIFF WILL GO INTO EFFECT BY OPERATION OF LAW

Issue Date: March 24, 2022

On March 2, 2022, Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty filed proposed revisions to its tariff under Tracking Number JG-2022-0230. On March 14, 2022, Liberty filed substitute tariff sheets correcting a summation error which occurred in the initial filing. On March 15, 2022, Liberty filed new substitutes for Sheet Nos. 67.3 and 67.4 which addressed two minor errors raised by the Staff of the Commission (Staff). The tariff sheets have a proposed effective date of April 1, 2022. This order addresses the tariff sheets as substituted – specifically Sheet Nos. 67.2 and 67.5 which were substituted on March 14, 2022; and Sheet Nos. 67.3 and 67.4 which were substituted on March 15, 2022.

The tariff sheets would revise Liberty's weather normalization adjustment rider (WNAR), and are a mandatory semi-annual filing pursuant to Liberty's WNAR tariff, which went into effect on July 1, 2018. This is Liberty's eighth WNAR filing. The purpose of the WNAR tariff is to adjust revenues, either positive or negative, for differences between actual heating degree days and normal heating degree days.

On March 16, 2022, Staff filed its recommendation. Staff explains that because the previous adjustment period experienced warmer weather than normal in Liberty's rate districts, the proposed WNAR adjustment would increase the average monthly bill, based on 100 Ccf of natural gas usage in a given billing month, of the typical residential customer by approximately:

\$5.00 in the Northeast District;

\$5.00 in the West District; and

\$3.58 in the Southeast District.

Staff recommends the Commission approve the tariff sheets.

The Commission set a deadline for responses to the application or Staff's recommendation. No other party responded or objected to the tariff sheets.

Based on its review of the tariff sheets and Staff's verified recommendation and memorandum, the Commission will take no action and the tariff sheets filed by Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty on March 2, 2022, as substituted on March 14, 2022, and as further substituted on March 15, 2022, and assigned Tracking Number JG-2022-0230, will become effective on April 1, 2022, by operation of law.
