MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

SBC Missouri¹ respectfully requests Commission action before July 30, 2005, on its "Application for Rehearing, and Alternative Request for Temporary Variance or Waiver," which was filed on July 14, 2005.

SBC Missouri requests expedited treatment here because of the impending July 30, 2005, effective date of the provisions of the new Enhanced Records Exchange Rule.² As explained in its Alternate Request for Temporary Variance or Waiver, SBC Missouri is unable, for technical reasons, to comply with the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission's") requirement for LECs to include Calling Party Number ("CPN") in the Category 11-01-XX billing records for wireless-originated calls.

In order to avoid the possibility that SBC Missouri may be found out of compliance with a Commission order or rule while its Application for Rehearing and Alternate Request is pending (when the Commission's new rules go into effect on July 30, 2005), SBC Missouri requests that the Commission grant a temporary variance of the requirement to include CPN in the Category 11-01-XX billing records it provides on wireless-originated calls (1) to give the Commission

sufficient time to investigate and address SBC Missouri's waiver request based on its technical inability to comply with this requirement; and (2) to permit SBC Missouri to complete its challenge of this requirement.

WHEREFORE, SBC Missouri respectfully requests expedited treatment for its Application for Rehearing and Alternative Request for Temporary Variance or Waiver and that the Commission, before July 30, 2005, grant a temporary variance from the Commission's requirement to include CPN in the Category 11-01-XX billing record for wireless-originated calls that would extend through the later of the (1) Commission's investigation and resolution of SBC Missouri's waiver request based on its technical inability to comply with this requirement; or (2) the final resolution of SBC Missouri's challenge to this requirement.
