ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE REPORT

On October 19, 2006, the Commission ordered its Staff to examine the estimated billing practices of Missouri's electric, gas, and water utilities. Staff was ordered to file a report of its findings by May 1, 2007. The deadline for Staff to file its report was subsequently extended to July 1. On June 29, Staff filed a motion requesting that it be allowed until September 1 to complete its investigation and file its report.

Staff's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. It will be granted. Since September 1 is a Saturday and September 3 is a holiday, the Commission will allow Staff until Tuesday, September 4 to file its report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Staff's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. Staff shall file a report of its findings regarding its investigation into the estimated billing practices of Missouri's electric, gas, and water utilities no later than September 4, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on July 2, 2007.
