ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION

Initially, the Commission granted the Staff of the Commission's motion to compel Laclede Gas Company to produce information concerning an affiliate. Laclede's motion for reconsideration was denied by the Commission and its motion for clarification was addressed. Upon Laclede's request, the Commission allowed the parties to present oral argument, upon which the Commission reversed itself.

Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel now seek reconsideration. For some time there have been four, rather than five, Commissioners. Those four Commissioners remained split on whether to grant Staff and OPC's motions. Now, a fifth Commissioner has joined the Commission and this issue may be settled.

Through this order, the Commission will reconsider its order denying Staff's motion to compel. Such reconsideration will require the parties to, again, present oral argument. Thereafter, the Commission will issue its order accordingly.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel's motions for reconsideration are granted.

2. An oral argument shall be held on September 29, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
