**ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO FILE A PROPOSED
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Symmetry Energy Solutions, LLC filed a complaint against Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire on March 26, 2021, regarding operational flow order penalties following a cold weather event in February 2021. On April 28, 2021, Spire filed its answer and a motion to dismiss the complaint for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. That motion was denied on May 26, 2021. The complaint is now ready to move to resolution. To that end, the Commission will direct the parties to consult with each other and to jointly file a proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall jointly file a proposed procedural schedule no later than June 10, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
