#### **VERIFIED APPLICATION OF PAPER,** ALLIED-INDUSTRIAL, CHEMICAL AND **ENERGY WORKERS LOCAL NO. 5-6, AFL-CIO, TO INTERVENE**

COMES NOW Paper, Allied-Industrial, Chemical, and Energy Workers Local No. 5-6, AFL-CIO ("Local 5-6"), by counsel, and respectfully applies to this Commission for permission to intervene in this proceeding pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075. In support of this application, Local 5-6 states:

This matter involves the application for variance submitted to this 1. Commission by Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede"), which application seeks changes to Laclede's current meter testing requirements.

2. Local 5-6 is a labor organization that represents for purposes of collective bargaining approximately 1050 of Laclede's employees in "physical" classifications such as production, maintenance, operations, and distribution jobs.

Although Local 5-6 is, technically, an unincorporated association, labor 3. unions are not required to register their names as fictitious names with the Missouri Secretary of State. Thus, Local 5-6 does not have evidence of any such registration.

4. The principal place of business for Local 5-6 is located at 7750 Olive Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri 63130. The telephone number for Local 5-6 is (314) 7218448, and its fax number is (314) 721-8789. Local 5-6's electronic mail address is gasworkerslocal@sbcglobal.net.

5. Though Local 5-6 is an "association," it does not seem to be the type of association to which 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(J) and 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) are directed. It does not appear to be the intent of those regulatory subsections for Local 5-6 to file a list of all of its members, and Local 5-6 hereby respectfully requests a waiver of complying with said requirement. Should this Commission determine that Local 5-6 must comply with the subsection, the required list will be tendered immediately.

7. Local 5-6 does not have any pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it as contemplated by 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K).

8. Local 5-6 does not have any annual reports or assessment fees that are overdue.

9. Local 5-6 seeks permission to intervene in this matter pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075.

10. As the exclusive collective bargaining representative of certain of Laclede's non-managerial, non-professional employees, Local 5-6 and the employees it

represents have interests in this proceeding which are clearly different from those of the general public. Where the public's interests here are concentrated in the dependable delivery of natural gas and related products and services at a reasonable cost, Local 5-6 and the employees it represents are additionally concerned with the impact the proposed tariffs could have on jobs and other terms and conditions of employment. These separate interests could be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case.

11. Local 5-6 does not have sufficient information about the proposed variance to take a position at this time and thus is unsure of the position it will take in this proceeding.

12. No other party to this proceeding can adequately represent the additional, legitimate concerns of Local 5-6 and the employees it represents here.

WHEREFORE, Paper, Allied-Industrial, Chemical, and Energy Workers Local 5-6, AFL-CIO, respectfully asks the Commission to grant this application and to permit Local 5-6 to intervene here.
