ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS AND STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

On August 24, 2020, Roeslein Alternative Energy Services, LLC (RAES) filed an application requesting a waiver of gas odorization requirements under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-40.030(12)(P) in operation of a gas transmission line in Putnam County, Missouri. RAES proposes to collect methane from hog waste lagoons and transmit the gas for injection into an interstate gas pipeline in Putnam County. RAES also requests waiver of the Commission's 60-day notice requirement under 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications. The Commission will also direct the Commission's Staff to file a recommendation with regard to RAES' application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's data center shall provide notice of this order and RAES' application to the county commission for Putnam County, Missouri.
- 2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of this order to news media serving residents in Putnam County and members of the General Assembly representing residents in Putnam County.

3. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than September 24, 2020. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing and information system or delivered to:

- 4. No later than September 24, 2020, the Commission's Staff shall file either a recommendation regarding RAES' application or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation.
