AND SETTING TIME FOR INTERVENTION**

On August 18, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff (Tracking No. JG-2017-0033) intended to end its current infrastructure system replacement surcharge (ISRS) and reset the value to zero. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission has filed a motion for the Commission to approve the tariff sheets filed by Ameren Missouri. Additionally, Staff requests the opening of this case to receive Staff's final report with regard to Ameren Missouri's ISRS over- or under-recovery for the period May 1, 2015 through September 16, 2016.

The Commission will provide notice of this case to all the parties in Ameren Missouri's last general rate case for natural gas service, GR-2010-0363, current electric service general rate case, ER-2016-0179, and Ameren Missouri's last ISRS case, GO-2014-0015, and set a time for interventions.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send notice of this tariff to all the parties in Case Nos. GR-2010-0363, GO-2014-0015, and ER-2016-0179.

2. Any party wishing to intervene in this matter shall file a request for intervention no later than September 12, 2016.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.




