**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO
MOTION TO EXTEND CASE**

The Commission opened this case by order issued on September 28, 2016 at the request of the Office of the Public Counsel to facilitate its investigation into the eligibility of expenses being recovered by natural gas distribution companies through Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharges (ISRS). The establishment of this case allowed Public Counsel to submit data requests to the companies without seeking a further discovery order from the Commission. The Commission's order indicated the case would be closed in six months, unless Public Counsel showed good cause for an extension of time. On March 20, Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the time for which the case may remain open.

Before the Commission decides whether to grant the extension requested by Public Counsel, it will establish a time for the filing of responses to that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's Motion to Continue Docket shall do so no later than March 24, 2017.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.


