On July 2, 2020, in response to the national COVID-19 emergency, Spire Missouri, Inc. (Spire) filed tariffs and a motion for expedited treatment. Spire asks to expand its Low-Income Energy Affordability Program beyond what it requested in File No. GT-2020-0316.

The tariffs bear an effective date of August 1, 2020. However, Spire asks that the tariffs become effective no later than July 18, 2020.

The Commission will allow time for responses.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party who wishes to respond shall do so no later than noon, July 7, 2020.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
