**ORDER APPROVING WNAR ADJUSTMENT TARIFF**

Issue Date: August 10, 2022

Effective Date: September 1, 2022

On July 1, 2022, Spire Missouri Inc.'s d/b/a Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West (Spire) filed tariff sheets (Tracking Number JG-2023-0002) with a proposed effective date of September 1, 2022. The proposed tariff sheets would revise Spire's weather normalization adjustment rider (WNAR). This is Spire's second WNAR filing since its most recent rate case, GR-2021-0108, which authorized Spire to file a WNAR that changed the mechanism from a semiannual mechanism to an annual mechanism. The existing WNAR rates will zero out as of September 1, 2022, and this adjustment to the WNAR will allow the rider to continue without interruption. The purpose of the WNAR tariff is to adjust revenues, either positive or negative, for differences between actual heating degree days and normal heating degree days. Spire's proposed tariff sheets would change the WNAR rate for Spire East from (\$0.00482)<sup>1</sup> per Ccf to \$0.01599 per Ccf, and from (\$0.00072) per Ccf to \$0.01357 per Ccf for Spire West.

On July 20, 2022, the Commission's Staff filed its recommendation about Spire's proposed WNAR adjustments. Staff explains the proposed WNAR adjustment would increase the average monthly bill of a residential customer using 100 Ccf a month by

\$2.08 for Spire East customers, and \$1.43 for Spire West customers. Staff recommends the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheets. The Commission allowed until July 27, 2022, for any responses to the tariff sheets or Staff's recommendation, but received no responses.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and memorandum. The Commission will approve the Spire' proposed WNAR tariff sheets. The Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days, so that the tariff sheets become effective on their proposed effective date.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The following tariff sheets, filed by Spire on July 1, 2022, and assigned Tracking Number JG-2023-0002, are approved to become effective on September 1, 2022:
