**KCP&L GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY'S

In support of its motion, KCP&L-GMO states as follows:

1. On July 7, 2009, the Commission issued its Order Scheduling A Prehearing Conference in this matter for Tuesday, July 21, 2009 at 2 p.m.
2. The undersigned counsel and other technical representatives of the Company have a previously scheduled conflict in Kansas City at the time of the prehearing conference.
