

- C. All Customer requests for service under the EDR shall be considered by the Company. Service under the EDR shall be evidenced by a contract between the Customer and the Company disclosing the qualifying locations, Customer accounts or meter numbers, and steam volumes, as necessary.

C. In determining the Company's revenue requirement for ratemaking purposes, test year revenues shall be restated to reflect the revenues that would have resulted from application of the LCS tariff without the rate discount for the EDR qualified volumes.

VI. ADJUSTMENTS, SURCHARGES AND CREDITS.

The rates and charges hereunder are subject to adjustments, surcharges or credits pursuant to the Production Adjustment Cost Clause ("PACC").

VII. TAX ADJUSTMENT.

There shall be added to the monthly bill of the Customer, as separate items, a surcharge equal to the proportionate part of any license, occupation or other similar fee or tax applicable to steam service by the Company to the Customer, which fee or tax is imposed upon the Company by taxing authorities on the basis of the gross receipts, net receipts or revenues from the steam sales by the Company.

VIII. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

Except as modified by this schedule, all Customers shall be subject to the General Rules And Regulation which are filed Separately.

All sales of steam service to Customers qualifying under the general rates for steam service (PSC Mo. No. 1) offered by Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. (the "Company") on and after the effective date hereof will be subject to adjustment pursuant to the Production Adjustment Cost Clause ("PACC") set forth herein.

I. AVAILABILITY.

Name of Issuing Corporation

The Company will file quarterly rate adjustments to reflect changes in the actual variable fuel and consumable costs essential to the production of steam. The PACC shall encompass all variable costs of Fuel (See Section III.A Below), and Consumable Costs (See III.B Below) above and below the amount included in base rates of \$8.304 per thousand pounds of steam ("MLBs").

Customer usage substantially occurs during winter heating periods, with many Customers purchasing reduced or no steam during summer months. To mitigate potential cost shifting between Customers and/or Customer classes due to seasonally unique steam usage patterns, each quarterly PACC filing plus reconciling adjustments, if any, will be billed to each individual Customer in twelve (12) equal installments based on each Customer's actual steam usage during that originating quarter in addition to all other charges otherwise billable to each Customer under applicable tariff provisions.

CALCULATIONS. II.

A. **Current Quarterly PACC:**

The Current PACC rate component is designed to reflect each Customer's share of the variation in fuel, and consumable costs for the most recent quarter. The difference between actual fuel and consumable costs and the amount of Fuel and consumable costs included in base rates (both on a per MLB basis) is multiplied by the actual MLB sales to tariff Customers during the most recent calendar quarter to determine the total variance to be collected or credited. To determine the amount of an individual Customer's responsibility, the difference (on a per MLB basis) is multiplied by the actual MLB sales to that individual Customer during the most recent calendar quarter, with the resulting variance charged or credited to the Customer in twelve equal installments.

Any overcollection of intended revenues will be applied to Customer bills through a Reconciling Adjustment. The Company shall use an amortization period of twelve (12) months to refund/credit or Charge any remaining over-collection or under-collection through the Reconciling Adjustment to Customers. Other fuel and consumable cost refunds or credits that arise through the operation of the PACC may flow through as a Reconciling Adjustment, as approved by the Commission.

I. AVAILABILITY.

The Special Contract Steam Service tariff is available to Customers with energy options, competitive alternatives or unique steam service needs, as set forth below. This tariff enables the Company to retain those Customer loads that might not otherwise be supplied or retained. The Company, at its sole discretion, shall determine whether retaining or supplying steam load to each qualifying Customer pursuant to a special contract is in the best interests of the Company and district steam Customers.

- A. Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc. (the "Company") shall provide steam service at the rates set forth in its Large Commercial Service or Interruptible Heating Service tariffs, or Standard Commercial Service as applicable. Steam Heating Service is also available under this Special Contract rate schedule for new or existing Customers connected to the Company's steam distribution system that have: (i) acquired or continue to maintain operable steam or hot water facilities and equipment serving or capable of serving as an alternative space heating source sized to provide for the Customer's total steam requirements; (ii) competitive alternatives for a portion or all of their steam service requirements; or (iii) unique steam service needs that require a special form of service.
- B. The term "competitive alternatives" includes all viable alternatives available to the Customer (e.g., Customer-owned or leased steam source equipment, conversion of Customer use to gas or electric service, or potential relocation of the Customer outside of the Company's service area) in lieu of using the Company's regulated steam service at the time the special contract was executed by the Company and the Customer. The eligible alternatives may not be contingent on future changes in Missouri statutes or Customer plans to deploy unproven technologies.
- C. Customers requesting service under this schedule must have annual steam consumption and must enter into a special contract written agreement for steam service with the Company.
- D. The Company reserves the right to determine whether this schedule is applicable or available to any specific Customer seeking to qualify its steam service pursuant to the above criteria.
