ORDER SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

Issue Date: October 10, 2018 Effective Date: October 10, 2018

The Commission opened this case on February 22, 2018, at Staff's request, to consider the propriety of the rates charged by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) for steam service in light of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, which reduced the federal corporate income tax rate from 35 percent to 21 percent. In its order opening the case, the Commission ordered GMO to "quantify and track all impacts of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 potentially affecting steam service rates from January 1, 2018, going forward." In addition, the Commission ordered GMO to "quantify and track its excess protected and unprotected ADIT [accumulated deferred income tax] for possible future flow back to ratepayers, and shall advise the Commission how best such flow-back may be accomplished."²

So that it can determine how best to proceed in this matter, the Commission will schedule a procedural conference and will direct GMO to report its quantification of impacts of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, as well as its quantification of its excess protected and unprotected ADIT, to the most current date available.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than October 24, 2018, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file a report quantifying all impacts of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 potentially affecting steam service rates from January 1, 2018, going forward to the most current date available.

2. No later than October 24, 2018, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file a report quantifying the financial impact of the amortization of its excess protected and unprotected ADIT from January 1, 2018 going forward to the most current date for which such financial information is available.

3. A procedural conference is scheduled for October 25, 2018, at 3:00 p.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
