## ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF PROPOSED DATES FOR ORAL ARGUMENTS

On March 6, 2008, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel (collectively, "CenturyTel") and Socket Telecom, LLC ("Socket") filed a Joint Motion by Consent of CenturyTel and Socket to Suspend the Procedural Schedule Pending the Commission's Ruling on Their Motions for Summary Determination ("Joint Motion"). The Commission granted that motion and suspended the procedural schedule on March 7, 2008.
