ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

As a result of natural gas incidents occurring on January 5, 2005, in Unionville and Milan, Missouri, the Missouri Public Service Commission opened a case to investigate. In the order opening the case, the Commission directed the Staff of the Commission to file a report of the incidents by June 3, 2005.

On June 1, 2005, Staff filed a motion to extend the time by which it must file its report. Staff stated that the press of other business has delayed production and editing of the final report. Staff asserts that the delay will not adversely affect any interested person.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and, finding it reasonable, will grant the requested relief.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's motion for an extension of time is granted.
2. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its incident report no later than June 17, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on June 2, 2005.
