ORDER DIRECTING THE STAFF OF THE COMMISSION TO ISSUE ADVISORY NOTICE

After investigating a natural gas explosion caused by a drill head striking a gas line during excavation near a residence in Fenton, Missouri, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a report.¹ In its report, Staff suggested the Commission authorize an advisory notice be sent to all electric corporations, telecommunications companies and rural electric cooperative reminding them of the safety regulations surrounding installation of underground cable or conduit using horizontal boring.

After reviewing Staff's report, the Commission issued an order closing the investigation and directing Staff to file for approval a draft advisory notice. On September 20, 2007, Staff filed its draft.

The Commission has reviewed the draft notice and is satisfied that the notice will alert electric corporations, telecommunications companies and rural electric cooperatives of the regulations concerning the installation of underground cable or conduit using horizontal boring. Staff will therefore be directed to issue the advisory notice.
