**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF AND  
DIRECTING FILING**

On June 8, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed proposed tariff sheets with an effective date of July 8. On June 27, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to either reject or suspend those tariff sheets.

Given the imminent effective date of the tariff, the Commission directed Ameren to immediately respond to Staff's motion. In a pleading filed on June 29, Ameren suggested that the Commission suspend the tariff for a short time in order to allow Ameren the opportunity to file a thorough response.

In order to allow Ameren an opportunity to file a response to Staff's motion and the supporting motions filed by the Office of the Public Counsel and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Commission will suspend the tariff for a short time and direct Ameren to file a response.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The proposed tariff sheets filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri on June 8, 2011, Tariff No. JG-2011-0620, are suspended until July 14, 2011.

2. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall file a response to Staff's motion no later than July 8, 2011.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
