STAFF'S MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and submits this Motion for Clarification of the Commission's November 2, 2011 *Report and Order*. In support of its request, Staff states:

1. Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.160(4) permits the Commission to correct its orders *nunc pro tunc*.

2. On November 2, 2011, the Commission issued its *Report and Order* denying Ameren Missouri's request to revise certain tariff sheets.

3. In paragraph 17 of the *Report and Order*, the Commission cites Ameren Exhibit 3, Mr. Shoff's Direct Testimony, in support of the finding "Under the Total Resources Cost (TRC) test, a measure in the Energy Efficiency Program with a TRC value greater than 1 is not cost-efficient."

4. In his Direct Testimony, Mr. Shoff testified "A TRC ratio greater than 1.0 indicates that a measure is cost-effective." (Ameren Ex. 3, 2:22.) (emphasis added).

6. In this same regard, it appears that paragraph 18 of the Commission's *Report and Order* was intended to state "there were at least 7 measures with a TRC value of less than 1," rather than "greater than 1."

WHEREFORE, Staff requests that the Commission clarify its *Report and Order* as discussed above.
