ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF AND DIRECTING FILING

Issue Date: June 13, 2008 Effective Date: June 15, 2008

On May 25, 2008, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) made a tariff filing (JG-2008-0680) to modify the terms and conditions of a portion of its transportation tariff dealing with the handling of imbalances and the reconciliation thereof on its system. The tariff filing carries a proposed effective date of June 15, 2008. Midwest Gas Users' Association (Midwest) filed an Objection and Request for Suspension of Proposed Tariff Sheet and a Request for Expedited Treatment on June 12, 2008.

Midwest alleges in its motion that the tariff filing will cause an imbalance in the way in which transportation customers "nominations" and corresponding adjustments, are handled by MGE. Midwest requests that the tariff be suspended for 45 days.

The Commission would like more time to consider MGE's tariff and the objections of Midwest. In addition, the Commission would like to receive responses to the objections from its Staff and from MGE. Therefore, the Commission will suspend MGE's tariff for seven days.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- **1.** The tariff sheets issued on May 25, 2008, by Missouri Gas Energy and assigned Tariff No. JG-2008-0680 are suspended for a period of seven days beyond June 15, 2008, to June 22, 2008, or until otherwise ordered by this Commission.
- 2. Any response to the motions filed by Midwest Gas Users' Association on June 12, 2008, shall be filed no later than 10:00 a.m. on June 18, 2008.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on June 15, 2008.
