## **ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO LATE-FILED APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On April 2, 2009, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application requesting a waiver of the Commission's regulation that requires the company to deliver a paper copy of the residential white page telephone directory to households and businesses in its St. Louis and Kansas City markets. The Commission provided notice of AT&T Missouri's application to the public and ordered that any party wishing to intervene file an application to do so no later than April 23. The Communications Workers of America filed an application to intervene on May 1.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. That means any response to the Communications Worker's late-filed application to intervene would be due no later than May 11. However, since AT&T has asked the Commission to expedite consideration of its application for waiver and the Commission has scheduled a prehearing conference for May 12, the Commission will shorten the time for response to the Communications Workers' late-filed application to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party that wishes to respond to the Communications Workers of America's Application to Intervene shall do so no later than May 6, 2009.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
