ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: September 13, 2005

Effective Date: September 23, 2005

On July 14, 2005, Sprint Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Sprint, filed an application requesting approval of its interconnection, collocation, and resale agreement with KMC Telecom III, LLC. KMC Telecom III did not join in that application, but the Commission added that company as a party in an order issued on July 15.

On August 12, the Commission's Staff recommended that the Commission approve the submitted interconnection agreement. But Staff noted that on August 11 it filed a motion in case number TD-2006-0078 to cancel the Missouri certificates and tariffs of KMC Telecom III. Staff filed that motion at the request of KMC Telecom III, which indicated that it was no longer doing business in Missouri. The Commission granted Staff's motion and canceled KMC Telecom III's certificates and tariffs on August 23.

Given that KMC Telecom III no longer had a certificate or tariff in Missouri, the Commission ordered the parties to indicate whether they still wanted the Commission to approve the submitted interconnection agreement. Sprint responded on September 13 by

filing a motion to withdraw its application for approval of the submitted interconnection agreement.

The Commission finds that Sprint's motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Sprint Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Sprint's Motion to Withdraw Application is granted.
2. That this order shall become effective on September 23, 2005.
3. That this case shall be closed on September 24, 2005.
