- SUBJECT: Staff Recommendation on the Tariff Sheet Filed BY MGE to establish an ISRS increase
- DATE: August 28, 2006

On June 29, 2006, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), a division of Southern Union Company, filed a tariff sheet with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) with a proposed effective date of July 29, 2006. MGE states its filing reflects its ability to recover certain infrastructure system replacement costs outside of a formal rate case filing via the implementation of an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS).

The Commission suspended the proposed tariff on July 6, 2006. This tariff filing was suspended until October 27, 2006.

On July 25, 2006, the Commission issued an "ORDER DIRECTING FILING". In that Order the Commission required the Staff of the Commission to file a Recommendation no later than August 28, 2006. This submission is in compliance to that directive.

This tariff sheet should be revised to reflect a total revenue requirement of \$3,679,127. This is an increase of \$1,290,779 over the previous ISRS composite rates currently in effect. Once approved, the ISRS revenue requirement will be comprised of:

The Auditing Department reduced the MGE's requested revenue requirement by \$2690. During the Auditing Department's review of MGE's revenue requirement, an error was discovered in the deferred income tax calculation. The error was corrected in the Auditing Department's revenue requirement calculation and MGE has agreed with the restated deferred income tax computation.

The Staff's analysis indicates that the proposed ISRS rates filed should be adjusted as reflected on the attached schedule.

The Staff notes that MGE's initial filing was deficient and at odds with the Commission Rule and State Statute when MGE added the existing ISRS to its customer charge when calculating the new ISRS rates. The Commission Rule CSR 240-3.265 states that "(14) The monthly ISRS shall vary according to customer class and shall be calculated based on the customer numbers reported in the most recent annual report of the natural gas utility so long as the monthly ISRS for each customer class maintains a proportional relationship equivalent to **the proportional relationship of the monthly customer charge for each customer class**." (emphasis added) Staff's attached schedule reflects the reduced revenue requirement recommended by the Auditing Department in the ISRS amount, and reflects the Commission Rule's method of computing the ISRS rates.

Staff recommends that MGE be instructed to refile tariff pages reflective of the minor revision set for on staff's attached schedule.

The Staff has verified that the Company has filed its 2005 annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. The Staff is not aware of any other matter before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing.
