**ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING**

On July 15, 2009, the Commission issued an order denying MoGas Pipeline, LLC's application to terminate the Commission's intervention before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. That order became effective on July 25. On July 24, MoGas filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." MoGas has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the Commission's order. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application for Rehearing filed by MoGas Pipeline, LLC, is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
