ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE REPORT

On February 19, 2009, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company, filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission asking to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") rate schedule. Section 393.1015.2(2), RSMo Supp. 2008, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265(11) provide that the Staff of the Commission may examine the ISRS filing and submit a report regarding its examination not later than 60 days after the natural gas utility files its petition. The Commission will order Staff to file such a report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a report regarding its examination of Missouri Gas Energy's Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge filing no later than April 20, 2009.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
