ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF, DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE

On March 12, 2010, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission to change its infrastructure system replacement surcharge (ISRS). With its application, the company filed a tariff that will implement the surcharge. Unless the Commission acts to suspend the tariff, it will become effective on April 11, 2010.

The Commission is required¹ to act on the petition within 120 days. Consequently, any order the Commission issues must be effective no later than July 10. Although the Commission may decide this matter sooner, the Commission will suspend the company's tariff until July 10.

The Commission is also required² to publish notice of the application. To that end, the Commission will require that notice be sent to those that may be interested. In the ordered paragraphs below, the Commission will set a deadline by which applications to intervene shall be filed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheet filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and assigned tariff number JG-2010-0563, is suspended until July 10, 2010. The tariff suspended is:

P.S.C. Mo. No. 2 4th Revised Sheet No. 34, Cancelling 3rd Revised Sheet No. 34

2. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall mail a copy of this notice to the County Commission for each of the counties in AmerenUE's service area and to the parties in AmerenUE's current rate case, Commission File No. ER-2010-0036.

3. The Information Officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall make notice of this order available to the media serving AmerenUE's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing AmerenUE's service area.

4. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than April 5, 2010, and shall be filed with:
