**ORDER TO DELIVER NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE**

Issue Date: February 27, 2013

Effective Date: February 27, 2013

The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering delivery of the information required by Section 393.275.1.<sup>1</sup> That statute requires the Commission, for each city or county imposing a business license tax on gross receipts of any electric corporation, to notify the governing body of any rate increase over seven percent approved for that electric corporation. The statute requires the Commission to notify those bodies of:

. . . the percentage increase approved for the utility, together with an estimate of the annual increase in gross receipts resulting from the tariff increase on customers residing in that city or county.

That information is attached to this order. Section 393.275.2 then requires the taxing authority to reduce its tax rate to reduce the amount of revenue collected under the tax.

Therefore, the Commission will order delivery of the attached information.
