## **STAFF'S GAS INCIDENT REPORT**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and submits its Incident Report:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission has statutory responsibility to assure the health and safety of employees, customers and the public service by natural gas corporations under Section 386.310 RSMo (Supp. 2006).
- 2. On July 2, 2007, the Staff asked the Commission to establish a case to receive staff's investigation report of a reportable incident which occurred on May 25, 2007, in Kansas City, Missouri, an area served by MGE.
- 3. Four MGE employees were injured. Two of these employees were hospitalized overnight and two were treated and released the same day. There were no fatalities.
- 4. With this filing Staff submits its investigation of this event with its recommendations.

**WHEREFORE** Staff requests the Commission accept this Report, and order MGE to comply with the recommendations in the Report.
