**ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFF**

Issue Date: October 15, 2009

Effective Date: October 16, 2009

On October 2, 2009, Atmos Energy Corporation issued a tariff to expand the existing energy conservation and efficiency rebate program and increase flexibility for Community Action Agencies in utilizing massive increases in federal weatherization funding. Atmos' tariff carries a November 1 effective date, but along with its tariff, Atmos filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the tariff to take effect as soon as possible. The Commission's quick approval of the tariff will allow the Community Action Agencies to use the increased flexibility, and allow the expanded rebate terms to become effective as soon as possible.

In response to Atmos' request for expedited treatment, the Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation regarding the tariff by October 8. The Commission also ordered that any other party wishing to file a recommendation do so by October 8. Staff filed its recommendation on October 8. No other party filed a recommendation.

Staff explains the tariff revisions will temporarily modify Atmos' tariffs to allow Community Action Agencies to use 2009 weatherization funding to "ramp-up" in anticipation

of massive increases in federal weatherization funding under the Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009. Staff says this modification will benefit Atmos' customers who will be eligible for weatherization services. The sooner the tariff changes are approved, the sooner the Community Action Agencies will be able to begin to ramp-up for the increased funding. For that reason, Staff advises the Commission to approve the tariff on an expedited basis.

For good cause shown, as allowed by Section 393.140(11) RSMo 2000, the Commission will approve the submitted tariff sheets to take effect on less than 30-days notice.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The proposed gas service tariff sheets submitted under Tracking No. JG-2010-0245 by Atmos Energy Corporation are approved, effective on and after October 16, 2009. The specific tariff sheets approved are:
