Under the rule, parties are required to notify the Commission 60 days prior to filing a contested case so that the Commissioners might avoid improper communications relevant to the intended filing.

Toward disposal of Public Counsel's motion, the Commission will direct the parties to file a pleading indicating whether each has any knowledge of improper communications concerning the subject matter of this case.

- 5. The parties shall file such pleadings no later than 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2011.
