The Office of the Public Counsel has moved the Commission to dismiss this matter because Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri failed to file a 60-day notice as required under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-4.020. Under the rule, parties are required to notify the Commission 60 days prior to filing a contested case so that the Commissioners might avoid improper communications relevant to the intended filing.

Toward disposal of Public Counsel's motion, the Commission will direct the parties to file a pleading indicating whether each has any knowledge of improper communications concerning the subject matter of this case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall file a pleading as described in the body of this order.
2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a pleading as described in the body of this order.

3. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources shall file a pleading as described in the body of this order.

4. The Office of the Public Counsel shall file a pleading as described in the body of this order.

5. The parties shall file such pleadings no later than 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 2, 2011.

6. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
