STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the Interconnection Agreement between Sprint Missouri, Inc. ("Sprint") and KMC Telecom III, LLC ("KMC").
- 2. The Commission's authority to approve or reject this Interconnection Agreement is pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 3. The Staff concludes that the Interconnection Agreement does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and the Agreement is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.
- 4. The Staff also advises the Commission that on August 11, 2005, the Staff filed a motion to cancel KMC's certificate of service authority and associated tariffs. In Case No. TD-2006-0078, *In the Matter of the Cancellation of the Certificates of Service Authority of KMC Telecom III, LLC*, the Staff advised the Commission that KMC is no longer providing telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and would like to relinquish its certificate.

Staff is not certain if the parties will actually need this interconnection agreement in Missouri; however, Staff recommends approval of the interconnection agreement as it meets the requirements of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends approval of the Interconnection Agreement.

On August 11, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificates of Service Authority and Associated Tariffs of KMC Telecom III, LLC (Case No. TD-2006-0078). In March 2003, KMC Telecom III, LLC requested the cancellation of its certificate of service authority at the federal level. On August 10, 2005, the Director of Governmental Affairs, on behalf of KMC Telecom III, LLC, indicated via e-mail to David Meyer, Senior Counsel, that KMC Telecom III, LLC's asset sale was completed on June 30, 2005 and that KMC Telecom III would like to relinquish/cancel its certification in Missouri. Given the impending cancellation of KMC Telecom III, LLC's certificate, Staff is not certain if the parties will actually need this interconnection agreement in Missouri; however, Staff will recommend approval of the interconnection agreement as it meets the requirements of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
