On May 18, 2009, all the parties to this case jointly filed a motion asking the Commission to establish a procedural schedule. Since all parties accept the proposed schedule, the Commission will adopt it with one modification. The proposed schedule calls for two days of hearing on June 11 and 12. A second day of hearing on June 12 would conflict with another event on the Commission's calendar. However, a single day of hearing should be sufficient to hear this case, so the Commission will schedule one-day hearing on June 11.

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

Parties File Factual Affidavits	- June 8, 2009, by 4:00 p.m.
Parties File Notice of Intent to Cross-Examine, or to Waive Cross-Examination of Witnesses	- June 10, 2009, by 12:00 p.m
Hearing	- June 11, 2009, beginning at 8:30 a.m.

2. The hearing will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
