ORDER CANCELING HEARING, ALLOWING LATE FILING AND ALLOWING ENTRY INTO RECORD

The arbitrator is canceling the evidentiary hearing, allowing the late filing of Mickey Henry's affidavit, and allowing the entry of discovery responses into evidence.

Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. (together, "Global"), and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("ATT") filed a *Joint Motion to Waive Cross-Examination and Cancel Hearing* ("joint motion").^[1] The arbitrator issued an *Order Reserving Ruling*^[2] on the joint motion, stating that the arbitrator would rule on the joint motion after the pre-hearing and mark-up conference ("conference"). After hearing the parties' responses to arbitrator and the arbitrator's advisory staff at the conference,^[3] the arbitrator will grant the joint motion.

Also at the conference, the parties agreed that, if the arbitrator cancelled the hearing, ATT may enter discovery responses from Global into the record no later than October 8, 2010, and the Commission will make such order.

ATT filed the *Motion for Leave to File Affidavit of Mickey Henry Out of Time*, asking that the Commission forgive a delay in the filing of an affidavit to accompany rebuttal testimony. The delay was less than a day. The Commission will grant that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion to Waive Cross-Examination and Cancel Hearing is granted and the evidentiary hearing scheduled for October 7, 2010, is canceled.

2. The Motion for Leave to File Affidavit of Mickey Henry Out of Time is granted.

3. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri may enter any discovery response from Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. or Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc., or both, into the record by filing such response no later than October 8, 2010.

4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
