ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES TO THE STAFF OF THE COMMISSION'S MOTION TO REJECT OR SUSPEND TARIFF

On January 4, 2011, the parties to Case No. GR-2010-0363, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's rate case, entered into a unanimous stipulation and agreement. On June 8, Ameren filed proposed tariff sheets with an effective date of July 8. On June 27, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to either reject or suspend those tariff sheets. Staff argues that the proposed tariff revisions are contrary to the terms of the stipulation and agreement reached in Case No. GR-2010-0363.

Given the imminent effective date of the tariff, it is necessary for Ameren to immediately respond to Staff's motion. Other parties to Case No. GR-2010-0363 may also respond. The Commission will therefore direct the Data Center of the Commission to send a copy of this order to the parties in Case No. GR-2010-0363.¹
