UNANIMOUS PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("MDNR") (collectively, "Parties") as directed by the Commission, and respectfully request the Commission establish the following proposed procedural schedule in this matter. In support of this request, the Parties state the following:

- 1. On January 4, 2011, the parties to Case No. GR-2010-0363, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's rate case, entered into a unanimous stipulation and agreement. On June 8, Ameren filed proposed tariff sheets with an effective date of July 8. On June 27, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to either reject or suspend those tariff sheets.
- 2. On July 13, 2011, the Commission ordered the Parties to attend a prehearing conference, which was held on July 21, 2011. The parties have been unable to reach a settlement in this case. Therefore the parties propose the following procedural schedule, and related procedural items for the Commission's consideration.
- 3. The parties have been unable to reach agreement on the issue of briefing. First, the parties disagree on whether or not reply briefs are necessary and further whether

allowing for reply briefs in the procedural schedule necessitates an extension of the tariff suspension. Therefore the parties request that the Commission determine whether or not reply briefs will be necessary in this matter, and if so, whether the tariff suspension will be extended, and issue an order directing the parties on the matter.

4. The agreed upon Proposed Procedural Schedule is as follows:

- 5. The parties also have agreed to the following procedures and request that these agreed to procedures be included in the Commission's Order setting the Procedural Schedule for this case:
 - a. The initial response time for all data requests is 10 calendar days to provide the requested information, and 5 business days to object or notify that more than 10 calendar days will be needed to provide the requested information.
 - b. After non-company rebuttal testimony is filed, the response time for all data requests will be 5 business days, beginning the day rebuttal testimony is filed.
 - c. Parties will provide a copy of all data request questions sent to all other parties to this case.

WHEREFORE, the parties file the Unanimous Proposed Procedural Schedule set forth above, and request that the Commission adopt the same and include in its Order its adoption of the procedural items requested by the parties in paragraph 5 above, and lastly direct the parties as to the necessity of post-hearing reply briefs.
