**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO
MOTION FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF TARIFF SHEETS**

On December 2, 2015, Missouri Gas Energy, an operating unit of Laclede Gas Company (MGE), filed a motion asking the Commission to expeditiously approve a tariff that MGE filed on December 1. The tariff would allow MGE to undertake a new, co-delivered pilot weatherization program along with Independence Power & Light. The tariff carries a 30-day effective date of January 1, 2016, but MGE asks that it be approved to take effect on December 15, to allow MGE to commence the joint program at the time requested by Independence Power & Light. MGE represents that Staff, Public Counsel, and the other members of MGE's Energy Efficiency Collaborative approve of the joint weatherization program.

To approve the tariff to take effect on December 15, the Commission will need to act at its December 9 agenda meeting. Therefore, the Commission will direct any interested parties to respond to MGE's motion by December 8.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall respond to MGE's Motion for Expedited Treatment no later than December 8, 2015.

2. Any other party wishing to respond to MGE's Motion for Expedited Treatment shall do so no later than December 8, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
