ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

Issue Date: March 13, 2007

Effective Date: March 13, 2007

Syllabus: This order denies the application for rehearing filed by Blakely
Manufactured Homes.

On February 27, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued a Report
and Order in which the Commission found that Blakely Manufactured Homes (Blakely)
violated the Commission rules as alleged in counts 1 through 9 of the Complaint filed by the
Manager of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Commission
("Manager") on April 7, 2006, and thereby failed to meet its statutory duty pursuant to
§ 700.100.3(6) RSMo 2000¹ to properly set up and install a modular unit. That Report and
Order further authorized the Commission's General Counsel to seek civil penalties from

Blakely Manufactured Homes pursuant to § 700.115.2 RSMo. That order had an effective date of March 9, 2007, to allow Blakely the opportunity to timely seek a rehearing before the Commission.

On March 8, 2007, Blakely filed an Application for Rehearing of Case under Section 386.500 RSMo 2000. Under Section 386.500.1 RSMo 2000, the Commission shall grant a timely filed request for rehearing only if in its judgment there is sufficient reason to do so. In the judgment of the Commission, Blakely has failed to establish sufficient reason to grant its Motion for Rehearing. The Motion for Rehearing will be denied.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for rehearing filed by Blakely Manufactured Homes on March 8, 2007, is denied.
2. This order shall become effective on March 13, 2007.
3. This case may be closed on March 14, 2007.
