ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ANSWER

On April 7, 2006, the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission filed a Complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Blakely Manufactured Homes. The Director sought, and the Commission granted, an order reducing the time allowed for answer by the respondent from 30 days to 15 days.

On April 24, the Respondent filed a Motion requesting the full 30 days to file an answer. The Respondent states in its Motion that it contacted counsel for the Staff of the Commission and that Staff counsel has no objection to allowing the full 30 days to file an answer.

The Commission will extend the time for Respondent to file an answer to 30 days from the date the original notice of complaint was issued.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent, Blakely Manufactured Homes, shall file its answer within 30 days of April 10, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on April 25, 2006.
