During the evidentiary hearing in this case held on November 1, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission ordered a single round of posthearing briefs. Posthearing briefs were to be filed on or before December 18, 2006.

On December 13, 2006, Respondent, Blakely Manufactured Homes, filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Brief. Blakely requests an additional two weeks to file its brief in this case due to computer problems encountered by its legal counsel.
