DIRECTOR'S STATUS REPORT

WHEREFORE, the Director prays that the Commission will take up and resolve this matter on the basis of his *Motion for Summary Determination* and any response in opposition that the Respondent may timely file, or, alternatively, set this matter for evidentiary hearing; and grant such other relief as the Commission deems just in the circumstances.
