**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULES, CONSOLIDATING  
CASES, AND SETTING CASES FOR MEDIATION**

The Commission is granting *Staff's Motion to Consolidate Cases and Set Mediation* ("motion").<sup>1</sup> The motion states that the Commission should consolidate the actions in these files, and CMH Homes, Inc. filed a statement of no objection to the consolidation.<sup>2</sup> The motion also states that the parties have agreed to the setting of a mediation session, so the Commission will convene a mediation session accordingly. The regulatory law judge ("RLJ") named below will conduct the session. If, after mediation, any issues remain for the Commission's decision, the Commission will re-assign this consolidated action to another RLJ.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any order requiring any party to make any filing in Files No. MC-2016-0032, MC-2016-0055, MC-2016-0067, MC-2016-0074, and File No. MC-2016-0032 is suspended.
2. Files No. MC-2016-0032, MC-2016-0055, MC-2016-0067, and MC-2016-0074 are consolidated under File No. MC-2016-0032.
3. The Commission will convene a mediation session on October 5, 2015, at 10 a.m. in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102. That building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the mediation session shall contact the Commission not later than the day before such event. 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
