This case is set for an evidentiary hearing on July 27, 2020. From the filings it appears that many statutory and regulatory provisions as well as codes and manufacturers' installation instructions and specifications may be in play. To assist the Commission and the evidentiary process and procedure, the Commission will order the parties to identify those statutes, regulations, Commission rules, codes, and manufacturers' installation instructions and specifications which they contend control in this case and stipulate, where they may agree, as to those statutes, regulations, rules, codes, and manufacturers' installation instructions and specifications of which the Commission may take official notice.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 24, 2020, the parties shall file a list identifying all statutes, regulations, Commission rules, codes and manufacturers' installation instructions and specifications which they contend control in this case.

2. No later than July 24, 2020 the parties shall file a joint stipulation identifying all statutes, regulations, Commission rules, codes and manufacturers' installation instructions and specifications of which they agree the Commission may officially notice.

3. The parties' stipulations may extend to other matters not described in the body of this order.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
