
Enclosed for filing are an original and three (3) copies of revised pages for Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a/ Sprint General Exchange Tariff. These revisions are filed in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations and submitted with an October 25, 2002 issue date and a proposed effective date of December 11, 2002. These tariff revisions are available on Sprint's website at www.sprint.com/tariffs.

The purpose of this filing is to modify rates in accordance with Sprint's Price Cap regulation, pursuant to Section 392.245, RSMo 2000. Within this filing, Sprint is adjusting its basic rates by the change in the CPI-TS as required by 392.245.4(a) updating its maximum allowable prices for non-basic services and adjusting certain rates as allowed by 392.245.11; and adjusting certain switched access rates and rebalancing to local rates, as allowed by 392.245.9.

All affected customers will receive thirty days advance notification of these changes, as previously communicated to the commission's staff. A summary of the rate adjustments and supporting calculations have been provided to Mr. William Voight under separate cover.

II. General Regulations (Cont'd)

- D. INFO-LINK is designed only to provide local one-way dialing to the Internet. This service is restricted to the transfer of electronic data. Voice traffic in conjunction with this service is prohibited.
- E. Unless otherwise specified, INFO-LINK is subject to the Rules and Regulations applying to all customer contracts as specified in the General Exchange Tariff of the Telephone Company.
- F. The minimum service period for subscription to INFO-LINK is one month and is billed one month in advance.
- G. INFO-LINK rates are incremental to charges paid by the customer for other services of the Telephone Company. Rates are on a per-line basis. This service can be used only in conjunction with Touch Tone Service and One-Party or Trunk Local Exchange Service.
- H. INFO-LINK charges will be developed on an individual case basis (ICB) when used in conjunction with Centrex service. Charges for the services offered on an ICB basis will be structured to recover the company's cost of providing the service. Terms of specific ICBs will be made available to the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff upon request on a proprietary basis.
- I. INFO-LINK will not be offered in conjunction with any Local Measured Service.

E. TOLL RESTRICTION

1. General

Toll Restriction service provides a means of restricting access to the Long Distance Message Telecommunications Network by direct dial or operator handled.

The service may be provided to individual line customers in exchanges equipped to program the service without alteration of the central office equipment. Toll Restrictions may be provided on access lines in connection with PBX or Centrex services.

1+710 Government Emergency Telecommunications Service Calls will not be blocked in the central office and will be completed.

Lifeline subscribers may receive Toll Restriction Service without paying a monthly or non-recurring charge.

Restriction of access to operator services prevents the customer from dialing an operator for all purposes including emergencies, assistance and the placing of toll calls. The customer indemnifies and saves harmless the Telephone Company from any and all claims, losses or damages caused by restriction of access to operator services.

In the event of an abandonment of the telephone, the non-payment of any sum due, the use of foul or profane language, the impersonation of another with fraudulent intent, or of any other violation of the lawful regulations of the Telephone Company, the Telephone Company may either temporarily deny service or terminate the contract.

D. Delinquent Account Charge

A delinquent account charge of **\$2.00** will be assessed to all customer payments received after the due date. **This** charge will apply to the current total amount due, less any disputed charges, for all services to compensate the company for the additional expense associated with delinquent accounts.

E. Disputes by Residence Customers

1. The customer shall notify the Telephone Company when all or part of a charge on the customer's bill is in dispute by written notice, in person or by a telephone message directed to the Telephone Company during normal business hours. A dispute must be registered with the Telephone Company prior to the due date of the bill in order for the customer to avoid discontinuance of service.
2. When the Telephone Company becomes aware of a dispute, a record of the date, time and place of the inquiry will be made. A dispute will be investigated promptly and thoroughly. An attempt will be made to settle the dispute in a manner satisfactory to both the customer and the Telephone Company.
3. If the customer fails to cooperate with the Telephone Company in efforts to resolve a dispute, the customer's rights to continuance of service will be waived.
