#### JOINT MOTION TO STAY SETTING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede" or "Company"), the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), and the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") (collectively "the Parties") and, in support of their Joint Motion to Stay Setting of Procedural Schedule, state as follows:

- 1. On August 1, 2000, the Commission issued its Order in the above-captioned case in which it, among other things, scheduled a prehearing conference for August 17, 2000, and directed the Parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by August 24, 2000.
