## JOINT MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF PROTECTIVE ORDER

Comes Now the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel), the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp) and St. Joseph Light & Power Company (SJLP) and for their Motion state as follows:

1. In its Order Denying Motion to Consolidate in Establishing Procedural Schedule, the Public Service Commission (Commission) acknowledged that the SJLP - UtiliCorp merger case (Case No. EM-2000-292) and The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) — UtiliCorp merger case (Case No. EM-2000-369) share many common issues of fact and law. On page 4 of this Order, the Commission also stated:

The Commission is concerned about the need to economize on the use of the regulatory resources of the Commission and the Public Counsel, as well as the resources of the applicants and intervenors. The parties are encouraged to take advantage of any opportunities that may arise to utilize discovery and testimony that are common to both cases.

2. Public Counsel and Staff have identified numerous data requests responses that have been answered by UtiliCorp in this docket which they believe would be relevant to the common issues of fact and law that are likely to be brought up in Case No. EM-2000-369, many of which have been labeled Highly Confidential or Proprietary by UtiliCorp. Although it would

be possible for Public Counsel and Staff to seek the very same responses from UtiliCorp in the other merger case, it would require a tremendous amount of time, effort and resources to be generated when the information is already in Public Counsel's and Staff's possession. Public Counsel, Staff, UtiliCorp and SJLP believe that certain intervenors in these cases are similarly situated. This duplication would apparently be required by Paragraph S of the Protective Order issued by the Commission in this case which states as follows:

S. All persons who are afforded access to information under the terms of this Protective Order shall neither use nor disclose such information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than the purpose of preparation for and conduct of this proceeding and then solely as contemplated herein, and shall keep the information secure and in accordance with the purposes and intent of this order.

3. Public Counsel, Staff, and UtiliCorp, believe and SJLP does not contest that considerable time, effort and resources would be saved on their parts if the Commission were to modify its Protective Order in this case to state that the parties to this merger case may utilize, in Case No. EM-2000-369, any data request responses answered by UtiliCorp in this case, as well as data request responses answered by SJLP in this case, which are not designated as Highly Confidential or Proprietary by SJLP, provided that such information is subject to the terms and conditions of the Protective Order issued in said Case No. EM-2000-369.

The amendment of the Protective Order being requested in this Joint Motion applies to material designated as Highly Confidential or Proprietary by UtiliCorp, but does not apply to material designated as Highly Confidential or Proprietary by SJLP.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel, Staff, UtiliCorp and SJLP respectfully move the Commission to modify its Protective Order in this case to state that the parties to this merger

case may utilize in Case No. EM-2000-369 any data request responses answered by UtiliCorp in this case, as well as data request responses answered by SJLP in this case which are not designated as Highly Confidential or Proprietary by SJLP, provided that any such information is subject to the terms and conditions of the Protective Order issued in said Case No. EM-2000-369.
